## Disaster Loan Outreach Center Closing July 2

**ATLANTA** – The U.S. Small Business Administration Disaster Loan Outreach Center located in Jackson, MS (Hinds County) will cease operations Wednesday, July 2 at the close of business.

The SBA urges homeowners, renters, businesses and non-profit organizations that are disaster victims to visit the Center before it closes to obtain one-on-one assistance and information about the disaster assistance program. The SBA also encourages those victims of the severe storms and tornadoes that occurred on April 4, 2008 who received physical disaster loan applications to return their completed applications by the deadline of July 28, 2008.

The deadline to return physical loan applications is July 28, 2008. The deadline for returning economic injury applications is March 2, 2009.
