 RED	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• DOJ achieved 26.02% not meeting its small business goal of 32.42% but exceeding the 23% Government-wide goal</li> <li>• This resulted in small business receiving \$189 million more than FY2006</li> <li>• DOJ did not exceed any of its socio-economic goals, however, made progress in the amount of dollars in all but HUBZone</li> <li>• SDB, WOSB, and SDVOSB received at least \$15 million more than FY2006</li> </ul>

### CRITERIA

 GREEN	THE AGENCY MUST MEET 100% OF ITS SMALL BUSINESS GOAL, 3 SOCIO-ECONOMIC GOALS AND <b>MAKE PROGRESS IN THE REMAINING GOALS.</b>
 YELLOW	THE AGENCY MUST MEET 90-99% OF ITS SMALL BUSINESS GOAL, 1 SOCIO-ECONOMIC GOALS AND <b>MAKE PROGRESS IN REMAINING GOALS</b>
 RED	DOES NOT MEET THE ABOVE (YELLOW) STANDARDS

**PROGRESS DEFINED:** SBA USED 1 OF 2 INDICATORS IN DETERMINING WHETHER AN AGENCY MADE PROGRESS ON THEIR SOCIO-ECONOMIC GOALS: (1) A PERCENTAGE INCREASE OVER FY2006 GOAL ACHIEVEMENT OR (2) FY2007 GOAL ACHIEVEMENT DOLLARS IS GREATER THAN THE ACHIEVEMENT AVERAGE FOR THE PAST 3 YEARS (FY2005-FY2007).
