 YELLOW	THE AGENCY MUST MEET 90-99% OF ITS SMALL BUSINESS GOAL, 1 SOCIO-ECONOMIC GOALS AND MAKE PROGRESS IN REMAINING GOALS
 RED	DOES NOT MEET THE ABOVE (YELLOW) STANDARDS
