The SBA also encourages those victims of the severe storms, tornadoes and flooding that occurred on June 5 through July 25, 2008, who received disaster loan applications to return their completed **SBA Applications by the September 15, 2008 deadline.**

Homeowners, renters, business owners and non-profit organizations can apply for disaster loans from SBA’s secure website at <https://disasterloan.sba.gov/ela/>. Business loan applications can also be downloaded from the SBA website at www.sba.gov/services/disasterassistance.

The deadline to return physical loan applications is **September 15, 2008**. The deadline for returning economic injury applications is **March 13, 2009**.
