NATCO, Inc.'s mission statement is to provide for the full participation of Indian tribes, businesses and persons in programs and services conducted by the Federal Government for Indians and to encourage the development of technical skills necessary to make each person marketable; to establish a program of employment which can support and enhance these skills; to support the right of Indian citizens to control their own destinies while preserving the Native culture and way of life.

Incorporated in 1994, the initial project was for the Shoshone and Arapaho Tribes, Department of Environmental Quality. The scope of this project comprised of cleaning up open pit refuse dumps and defiled areas on the Wind River Reservation. Other construction projects since have allowed NATCO, Inc. to expand their work history and develop skills in other areas. For example:

- Aggregate Crushing (BIA)
- Federal Highway Construction (WYDOT)
- Canal Cleaning Head-gate Structures (Shoshone and Arapaho Tribes Tribal Water Engineers)
- Tree Thinning (BLM)

- Spring Development (Fish and Wildlife Service)
- Industrial Site Reclamation (Nucor, Camwest).
